Mr Walters - Impact on Teaching & Learning with iPads;

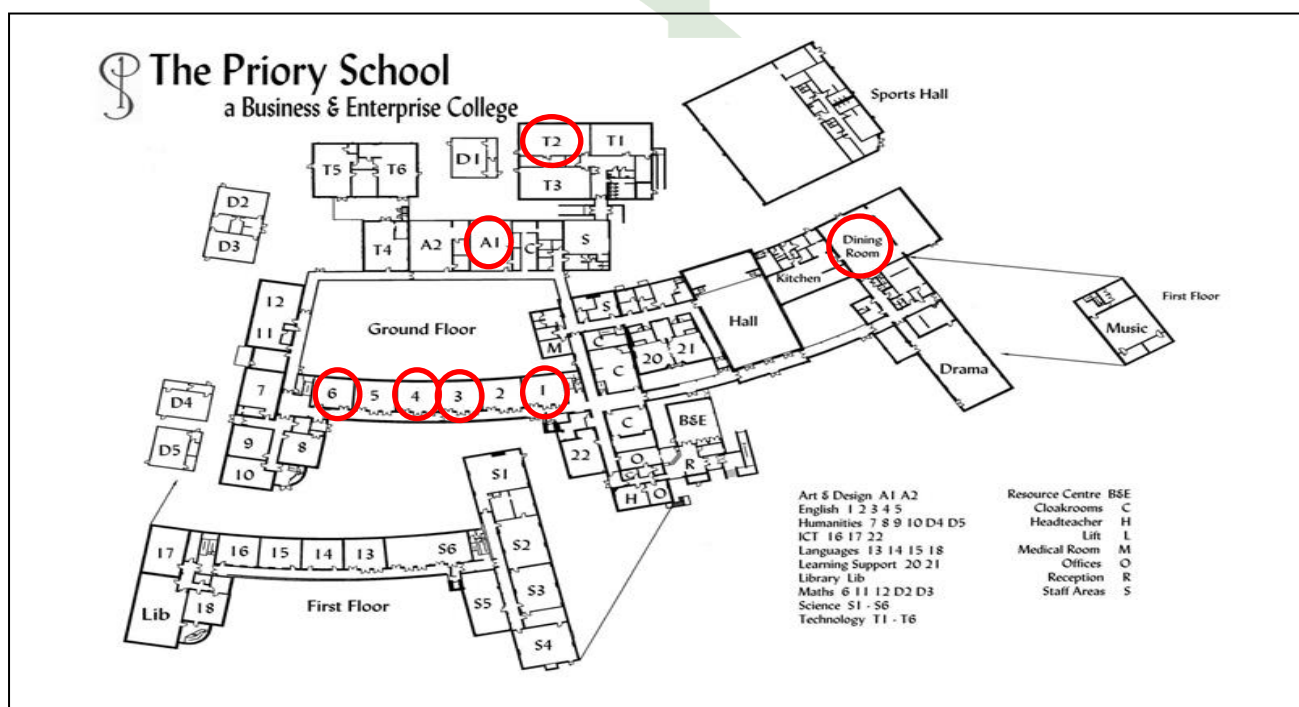
Mr Wright - Information on the purchasing process;

Pricing Model

Apple have announced over the summer that the iPad Air 1 is to be discontinued. As a result this year we have chosen to offer the iPad Air 2 32GB model instead.

This year we are offering the option to purchase outright, as well as a 12 and 24 month repayment plan. Each of these options include 3 years accidental damage and theft insurance and Warranty.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

If your child has their own iPad at home they are more than welcome to bring it into school for use in school lessons. The School recommends that the BYOD iPad is fully insured as part of your home insurance or through a separate policy and you must complete a BYOD signup form. These are available from the IT Office upon request and must be completed and returned before the iPad is brought into school.

What happens if I don't sign up to the scheme?

There is no obligation to sign up to this scheme and should you choose not to, your child will still have access to an iPad in class although they will have to return it at the end of the lesson and would be unable to take it home for their own academic/personal use. Once a student has left The Priory School, the iPad Air can be used at Sixth Form/College/University.

The scheme will also reopen during the spring term for delivery at Easter and parents will have another opportunity to sign up. However we can't guarantee the same pricing model or structure for future orders.

Distribution of Devices

Orders must be placed before the scheme closes on Friday 25th November, with the iPads being ready for collection on Thursday December 15th. We will notify parents of the details of the distribution of iPads in due course.
