## <u>Arrangements for 1:1 visits for prospective Year 6 EHCP students</u>

You will be aware that we are not able to hold our normal Open Week and Open Evening visits to The Priory School this September. However, we recognise that choosing the right school for your child is very important and even more so when they have Special Educational needs.

We are therefore delighted to be able to offer students who have an EHCP the opportunity to visit the school in person. If you wish to visit, please contact <a href="mailto:info@tpstrust.co.uk">info@tpstrust.co.uk</a> for the attention of Mrs White (SENDCo), giving your contact details. We will then contact you to make arrangements.

Please note the following in relation to visits to the school:

- Year 6 students should only be accompanied by one adult (unless in exceptional circumstances)
- Visits can take place during the normal school day but will be timed for when students are in lessons
- If you choose to visit outside normal school hours, this must be between 3.15 and 4pm
- Masks must be worn at all times
- Hand sanitiser must be used on arrival and at regular intervals
- Social distancing must be observed
- If either the student or accompanying adult has symptoms of Covid-19 they must contact the school to reschedule the visit
- Visitors will be pre-booked and must arrive at the allotted time, taking note of the visitor guidelines (these will be sent in advance to you)

Please be aware that these visits will not be as interactive or full as they normally would but hopefully you will be able to get a feel for the school and meet some key staff.

If, for whatever reason, you are unable to visit the school in person, we will happily arrange a virtual meeting.
