As you all know, students who have consented to take part in lateral flow testing will have their first 3 tests on school site. After this, from the 22nd March, testing will revert to the use of home testing kits which we will distribute to students between 12th and 19th March. Please read all of the attachments carefully as they not only go through how to administer the tests but also how to report a negative, or positive result; school will need to be informed through a specific link – please do not use info@ in this instance.

Please ensure you opt your child in or out, using the link to the MS form below, by the end of the day on Thursday 11th March.

Lateral flow testing is also available to the families of school age children through Shropshire public health. This is incredibly important in being able to identify positive cases within the wider household. If you are able to collect these they are available via the following links:
