

Risk Assessment Summary for Parents

Hazards Identified	Control Measures to Reduce the Risk
H&S exposure to the virus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students, who have consented, will have at least one negative LFT test result prior to returning to school • A further 2 LFT tests to be carried out onsite prior to transitioning to home testing • Following government recommendation – students will wear face masks at all times in the school building unless taking part in physical exercise or eating (this does not apply to students who are exempt from wearing a face covering) • Attendance will be monitored to ensure adherence to government self-isolation and shielding periods.
Testing – failure to report/inaccurate test results	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instructions for correct use of testing kits and recording of results will be issued to staff and parents prior to distribution.
Poor Hygiene	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classrooms are ventilated according to government guidance. • Enhanced cleaning throughout the day, including regularly touched surfaces and shared areas. • Hand sanitiser is available throughout the school and must be used upon entry and exit of the building and each classroom. • Students are encouraged to bring their own sanitiser. • Students must bring use their own regularly used equipment e.g. pens, pencils, calculators etc. (Please do not come into school to drop items off for your child as we will be unable to accept them). • Shared resources are sanitised or quarantined between uses according to government guidance. • ‘Catch it, bin it, kill it’ – tissues and lidded bins are in use each classroom. • Students will receive refresher instruction on correct hand washing and how to safely put on, take off and store a face mask.
Social Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will continue to be taught in year group bubbles which are within designated areas of the school. • Staggered start and end times will remain in place for year group bubbles as well as the designated entrance doors. • Break and lunchtimes will remain staggered with each year group bubble having a designated outside social space. • The dining hall will be split to enable each year group bubble to select from the ‘grab and go’ menu on offer and eat in the dining hall. • Students will be outside at break and lunchtime, unless they are eating or there is inclement weather. • Year groups will still have allocated toilets – cleaned regularly throughout the day.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• On days students have a PE lesson they can continue to attend school wearing their correct PE kit. PE lessons will be held outdoors wherever possible. If indoors groups will be split to ensure adequate space.
Positive case	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students displaying symptoms will be removed from the classroom and isolated until collected by a parent/guardian. If you are called to collect your child, please do not enter the building. Telephone reception and your child will be brought out to you.• All areas the patient has been in contact with will be closed until deep cleaned.• The headteacher will contact Public Health for further guidance on contact tracing. As a result of this appropriate contact will be made with those affected.
