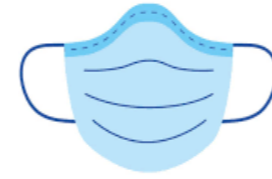


Testing and symptoms

- Please continue to test your child at home, twice a week, using the LFT kits provided by school or sourced locally.
- **If your child receives a positive LFT then book a PCR test on the same day and DO NOT send them into school.**
- **If they are identified as a close contact use MUST book a PCR test and NOT use an LFT whether they have symptoms or not. Please don't just do an LFT.**
- They can return to school if they do not have any symptoms.
- NHS test and trace will now identify close contacts, not school. Please give them as much information as possible
- **Please DO NOT send your child into school if they have any symptoms of Covid. Do NOT send them in before the end of their isolation period.**
- Main Covid Symptoms: High temperature, persistent cough, loss of taste or smell, headache, sore throat (it may appear as a mild illness in young people).



Face masks

Are no longer required to be worn by staff or students however if they choose to still wear one, they can.

We would politely ask all visitors to wear one in reception or when asked to if visiting school.
