Making payment for tickets of different prices on Parent Pay

To make payment for tickets, when tickets have different prices (e.g adults £6, children £4), please follow the instructions below:

1) In the 'How many would you like to buy' box enter the number of tickets you would like to buy for the first ticket price.

2) In the 'Choose payment amount' box enter the price PER TICKET for that ticket type.

In this example, 2 adult tickets at £6 each has been entered.

3) Add this to your basket. Complete the payment in full to clear the basket.

4) Go back into your payment items list. You may need to click the 'View all payment items' box at the bottom to see it displayed.

5) Repeat the process for the next ticket price.
