What can students be doing?

- Regularly revisiting notes there is a much greater emphasis on memory and the ability to recall now. If this becomes self-generated it will help so that everything is not left until Year 11
- Making sure homework tasks are done thoroughly and well these are often opportunities to practise exam technique and receive valuable feedback – the more you put in, the more you will get out
- Getting the balance right pace yourself and make sure you maintain other interests
- Think carefully about work experience
