**YEAR 7 - ENRICHMENT WEEK 24<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2024**

We are so pleased to be able to run our Enrichment Week again. We have an exciting and varied week of activities planned for our students to experience, which extends their education, and experiences, beyond the classroom.

A timetable of all sessions will be issued to students the week before, but the following gives details of any activities where a cost is incurred and/or parent permission required.

**Inflatables – in school**

The PE department have managed to secure the use of an inflatable obstacle course to be used in school as part of a carousel of PE activities that will take place in school.

**Dates:** Monday 24<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> June

**Other information:** PE Kit to be worn.

**Crocky Trail, Chester**

Crocky Trail is an outdoor play paradise with lots of activities such as winding paths, tunnels, mazes and slides. The outdoor playland is set in acres of lush greenery and jam-packed with spine-tingling attractions.

**Dates: Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June**

**Other information:** PE Kit to be worn. Packed lunch required. Change of clothes recommended. Return within school hours.

**Attingham Park**

A combined Geography and Art activity. In the morning, students will be practicing their fieldwork skills in the natural environment. This is followed by an afternoon of Art taking inspiration from the surroundings.

**Dates:** Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> or Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June

**Other information:** PE Kit to be worn with old trainers/wellingtons and waterproofs required for the geography element of the day. Suntan lotion if appropriate. Packed lunch required. Return within school hours.

## **Chester Zoo**

This is a Science Trip to Chester Zoo which ties in with our summer topic on ecology. Students will explore the park and exhibitions in small groups with a stop mid-day to eat packed lunch. The zoo has strict rules on student numbers in the shops and therefore there will be no opportunity to purchase souvenirs or food.

**Dates:** Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> or Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June

**Other information:** School uniform to be worn with trainers or comfortable walking shoes. Suntan lotion or raincoats as appropriate for weather conditions on the day. Packed lunch required. Departing school at 8:30am (students will need to be in school for 8:20) and returning to school for approximately 4:00pm.

**The cost for the week is £60.00**

We have done everything we can to keep the costs as low as possible but hope that this represents excellent value for money for the trip and activities we facilitating. This is available on Parent Pay for payment.
