# KS3 – Curriculum map

#### **Design Ventura Competition**

Students design a new product for the Design Museum shop and is an opportunity for students to develop design thinking, creative and business capabilities and employability skills.

#### **Moreton Means Business**

Selected students visit Moreton Hall to hear from a range of inspirational speakers about their different careers paths and participate in a number of workshops which focus on employability skills.

#### **Community Project**

An opportunity for students, in conjunction with Shrewsbury Town Council, to work on designing the floral displays close to the school with a topical theme. Emphasis is on transferrable employability skills and engagement with local community and environment.

#### **English at Work Day**

A range of employers visit school to explain to students how English is a vital tool within any workplace.

## Year 9

#### **Author Visit**

Students learn about a career as an author, the inspiration behind their stories and their journey as a writer.

#### **English Debating Competition**

A debating competition run by local solicitors Lanyon Bowdler where all students work on their debating, communication and public speaking skills.

#### **GCSE Options**

Students research a range of careers and GCSE options available to them. This is supported with a KS4 information evening for parents / carers and students.

#### Apprenticeship, Employment and Skills Show

Students have the opportunity to visit the show meeting with employers and learning about different careers and apprenticeships.

## Year 8

#### **STEM Event**

Students learn about different careers in science, technology, engineering and maths from visiting business people.

#### **Enterprise Challenge**

Students run their own mini business producing items. They must buy raw materials and sell their finished products.

Students meet people from a variety of different nationalities and employment backgrounds to learn some words in different languages and understand the importance of language at work.

## Year 7

### Enterprise Challenge

Students work in teams to design rides and marketing to launch a new theme park. The focus is on transferrable skills to help prepare students to the 'world of work'. There are also public speaking opportunities whilst presenting their work to the year group.

### <u>Cadbury World Visit</u>

Visit the Cadbury factory to apply knowledge learnt in the classroom learning about how chocolate is made and learn about Cadbury as a business.
