### Notes :

These grades are **Teacher Assessed Grades** in the light of changes to the GCSE system as a result of Covid-19. This year there are no performance tables and results are not being published nationally.

All GCSE subjects are now graded 1 to 9 with a 4 being a standard pass and a 5 or more being a strong pass.equivalent to a C and designated as a Standard Pass.

The Ebacc – this measure recognises students who achieve at least a pass in all of:- English, Maths, Science, a Language, History or Geography

A8 score – the point score achieved by students on average across their best 8 subjects. This is calculated by adding up the points for their best 6 subjects plus English and Maths whose scores are doubled.
