- Set homework via Classcharts that supports the delivery of the curriculum and mark it where appropriate
- Offer opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life
- Communicate between home and school through Classcharts, newsletters, letters, text, email and the school website

The Responsibility of Parents/carers is to:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and on time and to contact the school on the first day of absence.
- Avoid taking holidays in term time.
