
The data provided in these reports cover a snapshot of the last month and include:


- Key employers who are recruiting in the area.

In the last month, there were 5,754 job postings within the Marches LEP area, but 17% did not specify a location and are not included in the figures below.






Which job titles were advertised the most?




Who is hiring and in which industries?

There were 5,754 job postings in the Marches LEP area but 2,663 records have been excluded because they do not include an industry. Therefore, the chart below is based on 54% of job postings and may not be representative of the full sample.




Which employers are hiring?

Out of 5,754 job postings in the Marches LEP area, 55% specified an employer.




What are the most frequently requested specialised skills for these jobs?
