Students are permitted to bring a small quantity of confectionary to the theatre, however students will be reminded of their theatre etiquette and I therefore request that students use a small container rather than noisy packaging. Students will not be permitted to use their phone on the coach and this will be confiscated if students are seen breaking the school's mobile phone policy. Students will be given permission to contact parents/carers on the estimated return time to school.
